- A. This morning I'd like to talk to ALL THE MEN present about something very important. That something is what our world, our churches and our homes need from you.
- B. Our world is fast changing. It appears our nation, our homes and even a lot of our churches, are vastly turning away from following after the will of God.
- C. In Psalm 12:1, David writes, "Help, O Lord, for the godly are fast disappearing! The faithful have vanished from the earth!" I can't help but read that and hear the pain in David's voice.

A Godly Man Accepts Responsibility

- A. As a Husband (Prov. 18:22; Eph. 5:25-33).
- B. As a Father (Psa. 127:3-5).
- C. As a Child (Eph. 6:2-3; I Tim. 5:3-4, 8).

A Godly Man Leads Courageously

- A. Our world, churches and homes are in desperate need for spiritual leaders (I Cor. 11:3).
- B. Spiritual leadership should be demonstrated on a daily basis (Eph. 6:4; Deut. 6:4-9).
- C. Spiritual leadership begins with oneself (Psa. 112:1; Psa. 1:2).

A Godly Man Lives With Eternity in Mind

- A. Live with the end in mind and don't get caught up in that which is good in this life only (Heb. 11:24-26).
- B. Realize there is more to life than riches and pleasures (Matt. 16:24-26).
- C. We shouldn't wait until near the end of our lives to live with eternity in mind. We never know when the end is coming (Mt. 24:36-39).

Conclusion:

- A. When we look around, it's pretty evident that what we need is more godly leadership.
- B. Are you leading a godly life that is courageous and focuses on what's truly important?
- C. The Lord is looking down from heaven to see if there are any who understand, who seek after Him (Psalm 14:2; Psalm 53:2).
