- D. Jesus was born in a manger because there was no room in the inn (v. 7).

WE NEED ROOM FOR JESUS IN OUR RELATIONSHIPS.

- A. When we encounter people, they must see our walk as different than others (I Jn. 2:4-6).
- B. We should be willing to talk with others about Jesus (Acts 8:4).

WE NEED ROOM FOR JESUS IN OUR HOMES.

- A. Our priorities display whether Jesus is the center of our homes (Matt. 6:33).
- B. Our priorities affect the people around us.

WE NEED ROOM FOR JESUS IN OUR HEARTS.

- A. We must allow Jesus to have our whole heart and not just a part of our heart (Matt. 22:37-38).
- B. We must value obeying Jesus more than we value pleasing ourselves.
