# FACING JERICHO JOSHUA 6:1-21

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- A. In order to experience all that God had promised, Israel had to overcome a big obstacle (Jos. 5:13).
- B. Ultimately, Joshua and the Israelites were able to overcome the city of Jericho (Jos. 6:20-21).
- C. The account of Israel and Jericho is a great story about faith and obedience. However, sometimes we miss out of some of the valuable lessons contained within about our Almighty God.

#### GOD SEES OPPORTUNITIES WHERE WE SEE OBSTACLES (6:1-2).

- A. For many, Jericho represented strength and power and a great obstacle to overcome.
- B. God didn't see the city of Jericho as an obstacle to avoid but as an opportunity to shine His glory.
- C. We need to take our eyes off our obstacles and start looking at our God (Psa. 46:10, Matt. 14:22-33).

#### GOD DOESN'T NEED US TO ACCOMPLISH HIS PURPOSES BUT HE WANTS TO INCLUDE US (6:3-5).

- A. God had already given Jericho into the hand of Joshua and Israel. He didn't need Israel to overthrow it.
- B. God could accomplish His will without us, but he chose to include us (Eph. 2:10; Matt. 28:19-20).
- C. We need to look for opportunities to serve others and glorify God.

### GOD MEANS WHAT HE SAYS AND SAYS WHAT HE MEANS (6:6-19).

- A. This was a weird military strategy that made absolutely no earthly sense whatsoever.
- B. Joshua and Israel believed God and took Him at His Word and did exactly what He commanded.
- C. We need to obey all God has commanded us, even when it may not make sense (Rev. 22:17-18; Jn. 14:21; 15:14).

## GOD IS FAITHFUL TO HIS PROMISES (6:20-27).

- A. God had promised to give Jericho to Israel long before the battle ever started (Jos. 6:2; 16).
- B. Rahab the harlot and her household were spared because of their faithful obedience (6:22-23; 2:21).
- C. We need to live our lives in obedient faith so we can experience all the wonderful blessings God has promised us (Mk. 16:16; Mt. 10:22).

### **CONCLUSION:**

- A. The story of Jericho is more than just a feel good story about Israel's faith.
- B. Jericho is a story about the awesome and faithful God you and I are privileged to serve.
- C. May we come to understand and appreciate our heavenly Father more and more every day.
